## i) Arrangement dated 2002/02

- Securities subject to repo which were shown off-balance sheet until February 2002 were begun to classify under the items related with securities in the balance sheet since then. Thus the sectoral breakdown of repo and reverse repo transactions are reflected to sectoral balance sheets and monetary survey tables.
- ➤ The funds received from repo were added to money supply excluding repo transactions of banks with central bank and other banks in the period of 2002-2005.

## ii) Arrangement dated 2007/01

- The repo of banks with mutual funds have been shown by excluding the repo transaction with B-Type Liquid Funds beginning from the data of December 2005 with the arrangements made on January 2007 (In order to comply with international standards, definition of monetary sector is expanded to cover Investment and Development Banks, Participation Banks and B-Type Liquid Funds (Money Market Funds) in addition to the Central Bank and Deposit Bank).
- ➤ Repo transactions of investment and development banks have been added to money supply tables (excluding interbank and B-Type Liquid Funds) beginning from the data of December 2005 with the arrangements made on January 2007.
- The repo transactions of Central Bank have been followed under the sectors of "Banks", 
  "Intermediary Institutions", "B-Type Liquid Funds" and " Mutual Funds Other Than B-Type Liquid 
  Funds" and sectoral breakdown have been reflected to sectorel balance sheet and monetary 
  survey tables beginning from the data of December 2005 with the arrangements made on January 
  2007 (In order to comply with international standards, definition of monetary sector is expanded to 
  cover Investment and Development Banks, Participation Banks and B-Type Liquid Funds (Money 
  Market Funds) in addition to the Central Bank and Deposit Bank). The repo transactions of Central 
  Bank with "Intermediary Institutions" and "Mutual Funds Other Than B-Type Liquid Funds", 
  previously classified under "Non-Reserve Liabilities" of Central Bank, have been shown under the 
  "Funds Received From Repo Transactions" item. It has been added to "Funds Received From 
  Repo Transactions" item as a Central Bank repos in the money supply table beginning from 
  December 2005.
