Governor Erdem Başçı delivered a presentation on "Economic Outlook and Monetary Policy" in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Research Conference held by the National Bank of the Republic of Macedonia on Monday, 28 April 2014 at 10:10 a.m. local time in Turkey.

Governor Başçı emphasized the following points:

- Retail loan growth continues to slow down in response to the tight monetary policy stance, recent macroprudential measures, and weak capital flows.
- The impact of monetary tightening on inflation will be observed with some lag.
  Meanwhile, inflation is expected to peak in May, partly reflecting the base effects.
- Exports will support growth while private final domestic demand will lose momentum.
- The current account deficit will improve substantially in 2014.
