Graph 1. CUR and Seasonally Adjusted CUR (%)

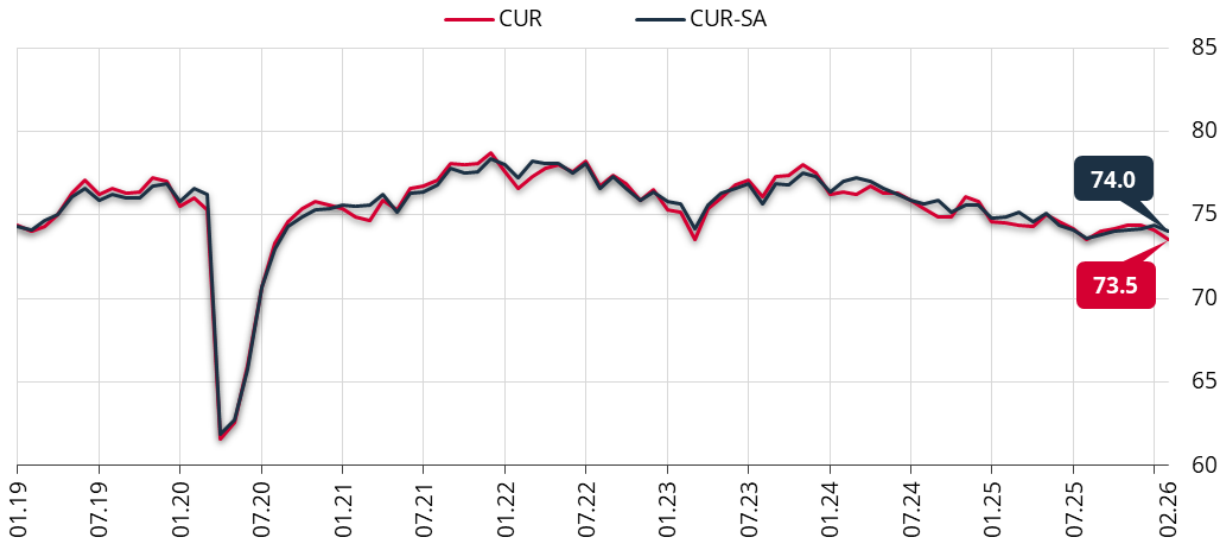
